Council Awards Contract for First Phase of 2018 Street Reconstruction Project

At the May 14 meeting, Council awarded the contract for Phase 1 of the street construction project. The contract was awarded to Pavecon Public Works, LP in the amount of \$523,307.39. In November, 2017 voters approved the funding for construction of 23 streets in Highland Village. Phase 1 of the Street Improvements Project will consist of Rosedale Street, Shasta Court, Snowdon Court, Sheldon Court, Sugarloaf Court, and Catesby Place. Some of these streets are in need of full reconstruction and others require an asphalt overlay to bring them back to 100% on the City's Pavement Condition Index. It is anticipated the contractor will begin work mid-June.

The ceremonial swearing in of newly elected Council members took place at this meeting. Mike Lombardo, Dan Jaworski, and Tom Heslep were sworn in at this meeting. Council member Mike Lombardo was elected Mayor Pro Tem and Barbara Fleming was elected Deputy Mayor Pro Tem.

Two proclamations focusing on public safety were given during the Mayor and Council comments. The Fire Department was recognized in celebration of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) week and the Police Department was recognized for National Police Week.

Also during the Mayor and Council reports, Matthew Anstead was recognized for completion of the Certified Playground Safety Inspector (CPSI) Program from the National Recreation and Park Association. The City is dedicated to providing advanced training to all employees. With Matthew's completion of the CPSI Program, we take the safety and security of our parks infrastructure as a top priority. Matthew's success allows us to monitor our playgrounds with City crews.
